In October of last year we had a congregational meeting regarding the financial situation of the church. At that time, several of you increased your tithe \$5, which has helped. In the last 6 months, I have only been able to put one (1) check into our savings account.

But we must remember that this is not a permanent situation and the time will come that we must, once again, sustain ourselves without the help of the day care rent. Also remember that whether you are here on Sunday or not (and I hope you will be) the financial needs continue.

I wish you all could have joined me in attending the contemporary and traditional worship services this last week. Collin Gregory finished his 3 week set with a sermon about evangelizing. It was a wonderful sermon and certainly gave me something to think about. WE all need to practice being an evangelist so that everyone we know can see how happy we are and what we have to offer at First Christian Church Burleson. Laura followed this up in the 11:00 service with a talk about tithing. I know this is the one thing pastors wish they never had to speak about. However, it is a necessity if a church is going to survive.

BOARD MEETING NOTES

April 21, 2010

Paul Holton, Liaison to the BISD Daycare Program, spoke with regard to an amendment to the contract with BISD. Considering the 12-months average, BISD will pay FCCB any amount over \$1,070.50 per month, or approximately \$400.00 per month, for utilities share, in addition to the contracted lease per month. Paul emphasized that we need to be diligent about cleaning up area used by our members on the weekends that are used by the BISD Daycare during the week, restrooms in particular, emptying of garbage cans, and replacing tables and chairs as we found them. BISD goes above and beyond in maintenance and repairs of areas of the buildings used for their daycare. Their janitor cleans on Friday evenings and the areas should be in that condition on Monday mornings when they arrive to operate the daycare. Chris Cooper volunteered to make up check lists to be posted in those areas used by our membership on weekends showing items to be attended to and checked off. Collin Gregory will report on this matter at Cabinet meeting.

Collin Gregory reported that the Pentecost worship service is being planned for May 23rd. With reference to the traditional services, it is felt that they should remain "traditional" and so the drums will no longer be played in the traditional service, and the music will be selected by the choir.

Audit Committee - Bobby Lewis reported that the audit for the year 2009 has been completed. The church is still struggling financially and funds must be pulled from the Contingency Fund account regularly to pay bills. All purchases for the church must first be approved by Peggy Johnson, Treasurer.

Bobby Lewis reported that he has requests for bids on repairs to the parking lot. The damaged areas are mainly on the end where paper and garbage bins are located, and that the damage is likely caused by the heavy trucks entering and exiting to empty those bins. He stated that we only made \$225.21 from the sale of the paper last year, and at present income from it is only \$18.77 per month. The damages outweigh the income by far. Chris Cooper moved we discontinue paper recycling. Motion passed.

Jerry Hay was approved to serve on the PPRC for a 2 year term.

Steven Burr, Youth Minister, has been with us one year, and there has been no salary increase. A motion to give Steven a 10% increase of \$100/month was approved.
